

Registration as a language student

In order to apply for a visa as a language student in Germany, you must first book a language course of a minimum of 20 teaching units per week (Monday to Friday). You can visit such morning or afternoon courses at any language level at the Munich Volkshochschule.

What can we do for you?

1. Before the application

First, at least 10 weeks before your planned stay in Munich, write us an email to deutsch@mvhs.de regarding your wish to register for a visa language course. The registration process can be done via email correspondence

We would like to ask you to print and fill in the 2 forms listed below:

1. [Registration card](#) for the courses M600000 with the amount of € 350.– (this is the amount that will later be taken for the course booking of a current course once your visa is granted and you can start with the course) and M600001 with the amount of € 20.– (this is the service fee)

2. Direct [debit/Lastschriftmandat](#) with the amount total of Euro 370.–

2. Information needed on our side

In a next step, please scan and send these 2 filled in forms to deutsch@mvhs.de. In your email to us, please also include your wish for

- The language level you would like to start with (A1 to C2)
- The start date and duration of your stay, thus indicating the length of time you would like to book language courses with us – please find the following information on course intervals:

8.11. to 17.12.2021

Course intervals 2022

17.01. to 25.02.2022
07.03. to 09.04.2022
25.04. to 03.06.2022

It is important to note the starting level and the level you would like to complete at the end of your stay. During one course interval, one of the following sublevels will be completed:

A1.1 / A1.2 / A2.1 / A2.2 / B1.1 / B1.2 / B2.1 / B2.2 / C1.1 / C1.2 / C2.1 / C2.2 .

Exams are offered separately from these courses at the end of each language level (A1 / A2 / B1 / B2 / C1 / C2) .

We recommend you take an online free of charge placement test beforehand:

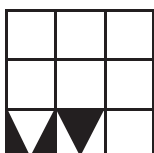

Subsequently, you will be sent per email, a registration card for a visa language course AND, for the above mentioned € 20.– fee, a confirmation of the course dates indicating the entire length of stay, please allow a few days for us to issue and forward this to you per email.

This confirmation can be taken to apply for your visa. The paper should be passed to the KVR or German representative (for example embassy) in your home country. You can, if the German representative/embassy requires, pay for more than one course in advance.



3. Visa is granted

As soon as the visa has been granted, contact us immediately via email at deutsch@mvhs.de, with your registration card and proof of current German level. We recommend the free online placement tests listed above, also to be found at www.mvhs.de/deutschkurse.

We will then exchange your visa course for a course suited to your level and the next available start date.

3a. Visa is not granted

Should the visa not be granted, you will be refunded the full amount paid minus a cancellation fee of € 10.–. The above mentioned service fee of € 20 is non-refundable.

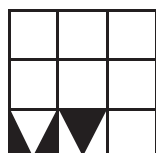
